POSTER AWARD

Eligibility

To apply for the Young Scientist Poster Award, you must:

1. Be first author on the poster
2. Be a current student or have received your PhD no more than 2 years prior to the SSM meeting (i.e., after May 2018)
3. Attend the 2020 SSM meeting and be available for questions during the poster session

Prize

The recipient of the award will receive:

1. An official “Society for the Study of Motivation 2020 Young Scientist Poster Award” certificate with the title of the poster and the author name(s) and affiliation(s)
2. A three-year SSM membership for the coming years (2021-2023)
3. A prominent place during the poster session

Submissions

To apply for the award:

1. Submit your poster abstract (150-word maximum) to the SSM Program Committee (see [Call for Submissions](#)) and indicate that your poster submission is eligible for the Young Scientist Poster Award.
2. When your poster is accepted by the Program Committee for the 2020 SSM conference, you will receive an invitation to send your final poster to the Award committee.

Dates and deadlines

- **February 7th 2020:** Submission deadline for all poster presentations.
- **February 28th 2020:** Submitters will be notified of conference acceptance via e-mail.
- **April 20th 2020:** Deadline to send your final poster as a PDF to the Award Committee (kerstin.brinkmann@unige.ch) with “SSM Poster Award” in the subject line.
- **May 8th 2020:** The winner of the Young Scientist Poster Award is announced.

Note: Even if you did not indicate in the abstract submission that you would like to be considered for the Young Scientist Poster Award, you can still participate by sending your final poster PDF to the Award Committee by April 20.
